Acceptable Materials and Instructions

Household garbage

Solely for materials which are not accepted in other collections or at écocentres.



PLASTIC BAG

METAL OR PLASTIC CONTAINER WITH HANDLES

Max. 25 kg (55 lb)

WHEELED BIN (EXCEPT BLUE BINS)

Max. 100 kg (220 lb)

Prohibited materials

- Green waste
- Branches and tree trimmings
- Construction, renovation and demolition (CRD) waste
- Wooden furniture
- Recyclable materials
- Tires
- Electronics
- Cooling appliances (containing halocarbons)
- Household hazardous waste (HHW)

Recyclable Materials

Containers, packaging, printed materials and newspapers

- Paper and cardboard
- Plastic
- Glass
- Metal

Collected each week for buildings with nine (9) or more units.

SURPLUS ACCEPTED

NEW: SURPLUS NEXT TO THE BIN ARE NOW ACCEPTED

Terms and conditions:

- Cardboards must be flattened and / or placed in a box.
- Cardboards should not exceed 1.5 m X 1.5 m (5' X 5').
- Cardboards must be free of other materials and not be sullied.
- Surplus placed out in transparent plastic bags are accepted.

Green Waste

- Grass and lawn clippings
- Household plants, dead leaves, vines and cedar branches
- Plant waste from gardening and landscaping
- Pumpkins and fallen fruits from trees

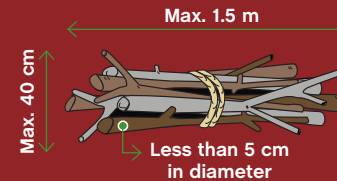

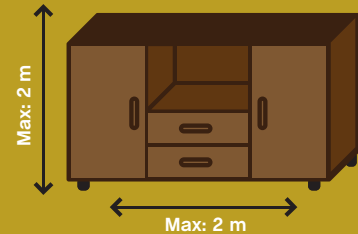
BRANCHES TIED TOGETHER

Branches exceeding 5 cm in diameter must be taken to an écocentre.

BAGS AND BOXES ARE NOT ACCEPTED FOR THESE COLLECTIONS

Bulky Wooden Waste (Large Items)

Maximum total volume per collection: 5 m³



Terms and conditions:

- Only wooden waste without any glass, plastic or shingles will be accepted.
- Waste must be able to be transported by two (2) people.
- Waste must be free of nails and screws (or they must be bent flat).
- If it consists of small pieces or bits of wood, waste must be placed in reusable containers.
- Bags and boxes are not accepted.

GYPSONUM AND OTHER NON WOODEN CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS ARE NOT ACCEPTED
